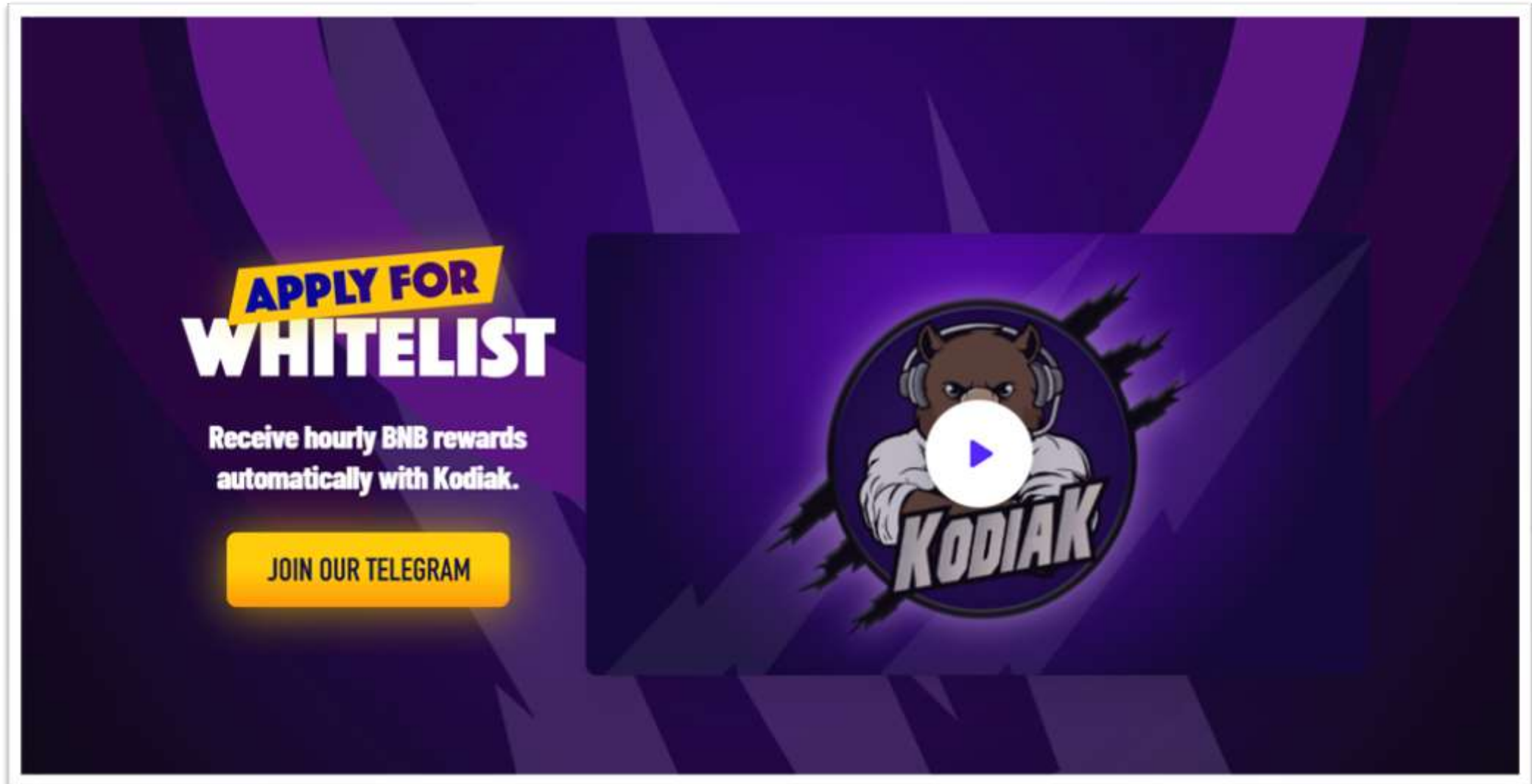

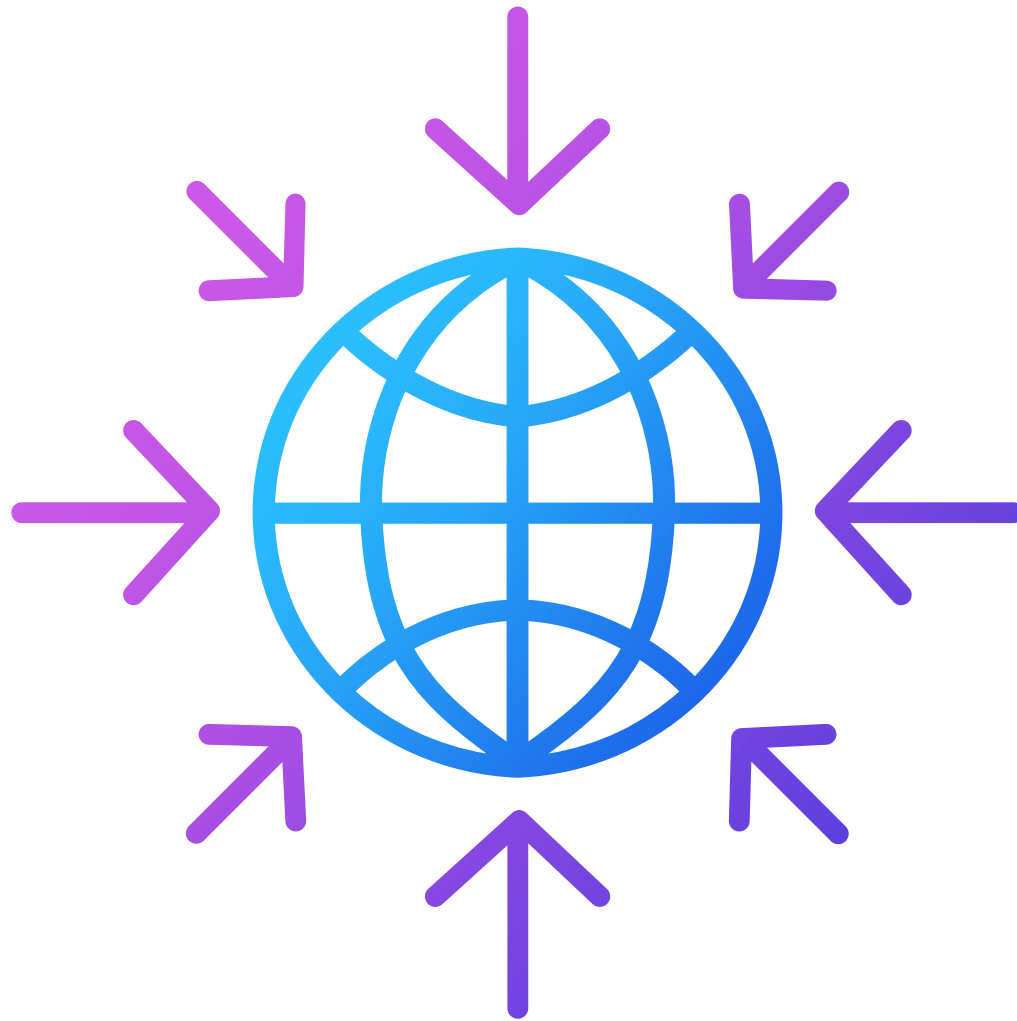

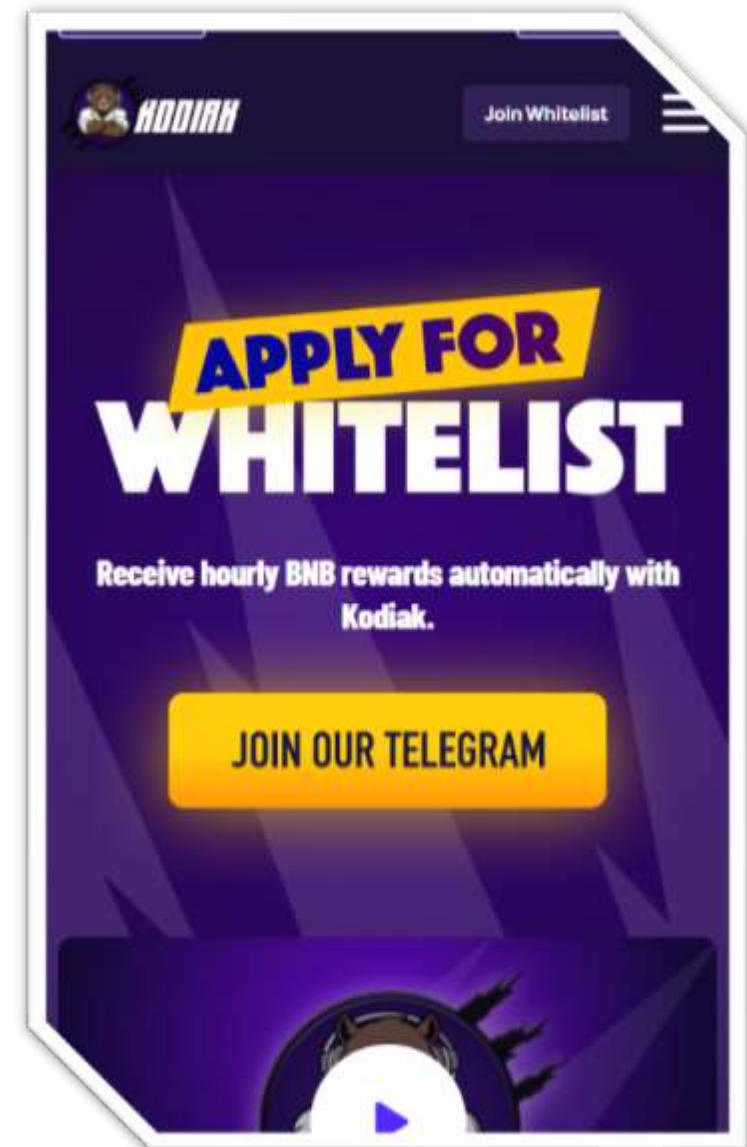
The website contained no JavaScript errors. No typos, or grammatical errors were present, and we found a valid SSL certificate allowing for access via https.

We were able to track down multiple social media channels for the project. Social Media channels included Twitter, Telegram, Facebook, and Instagram. All social media channels had a healthy amount of activity.

It is important to note that there is an 13% tax on EVERY transaction including buys and sells. 3% goes to providing liquidity, 7% is distributed to the token holders in BNB and 3% of every transaction is distributed back to the team to be used for marketing purposes.

We were unable to find a contact email on the main website. We would like to see this added as a more official means of communication. **✓ Resolved**

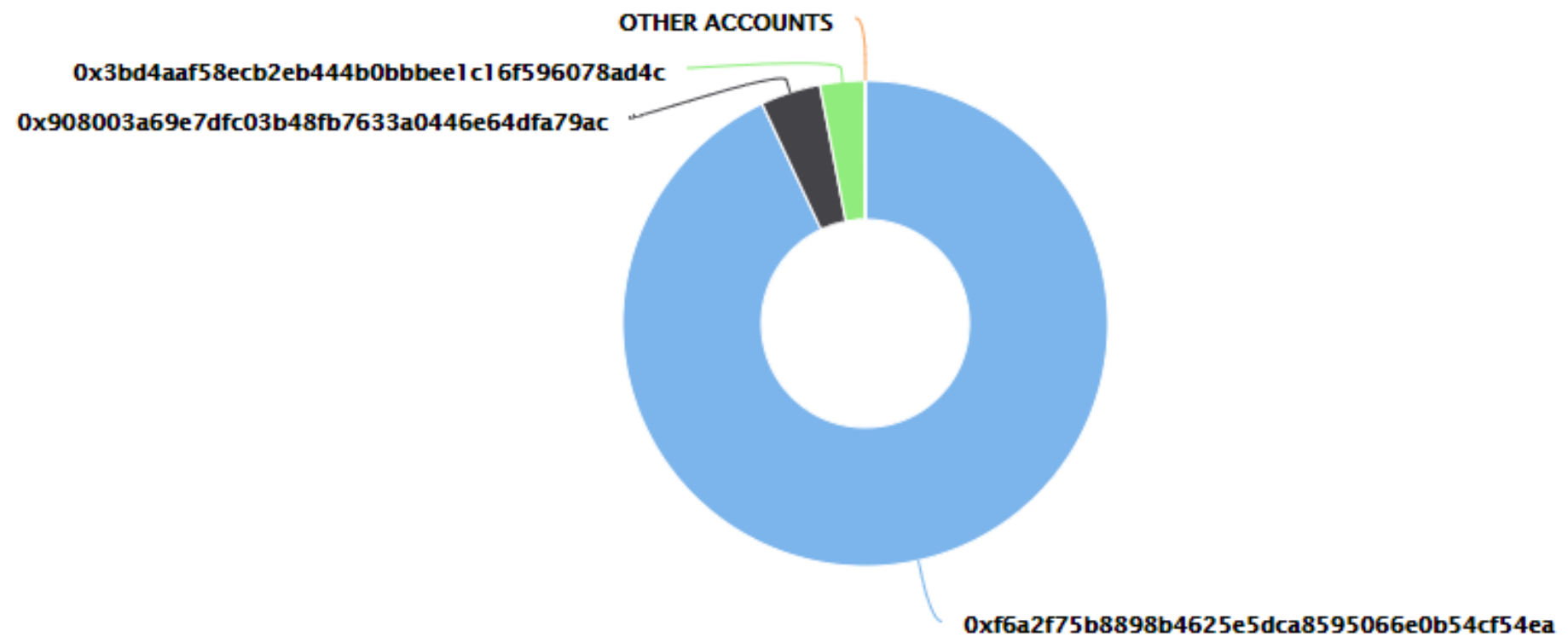

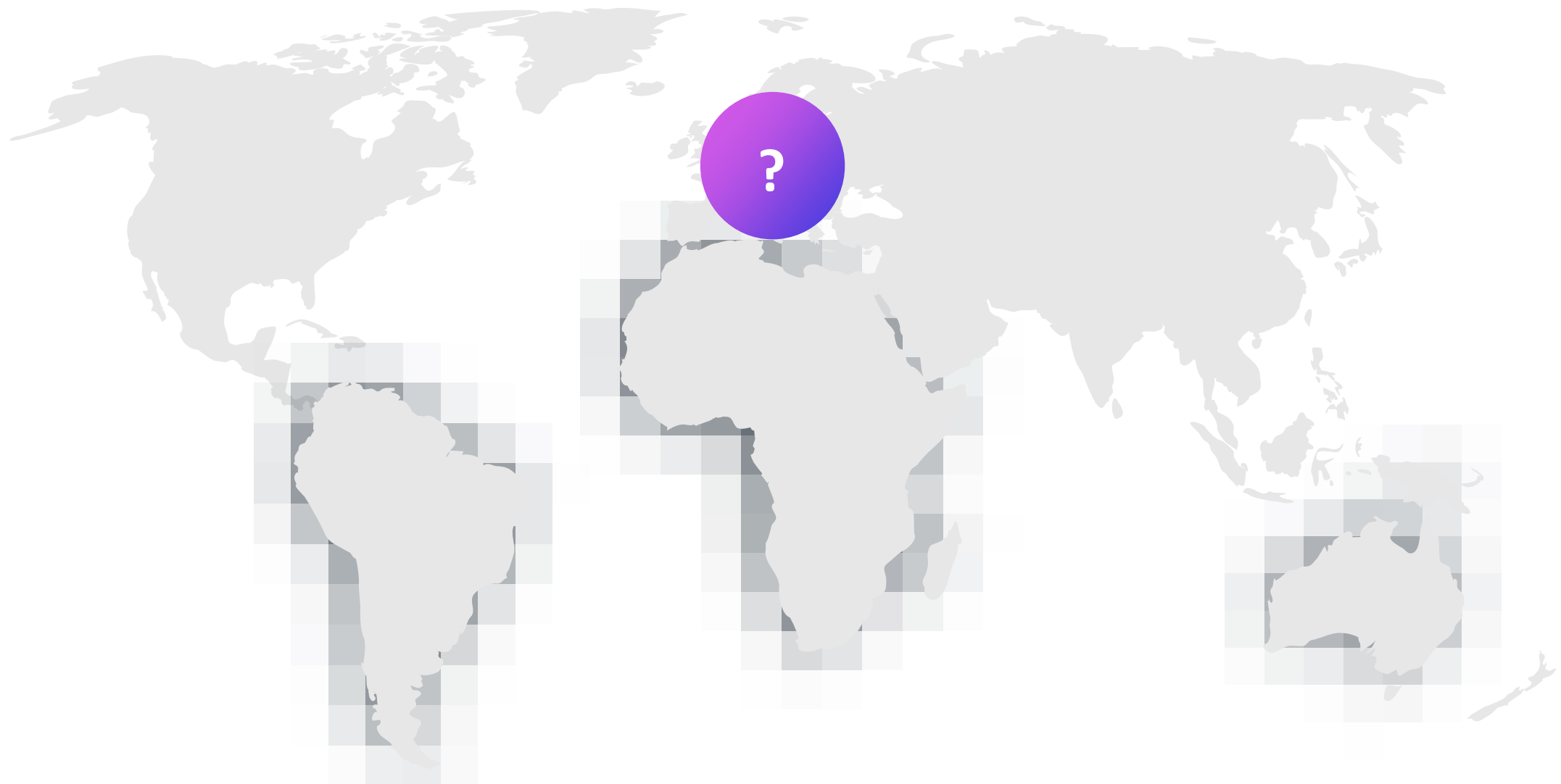
Kodiak Top 100 Token Holders

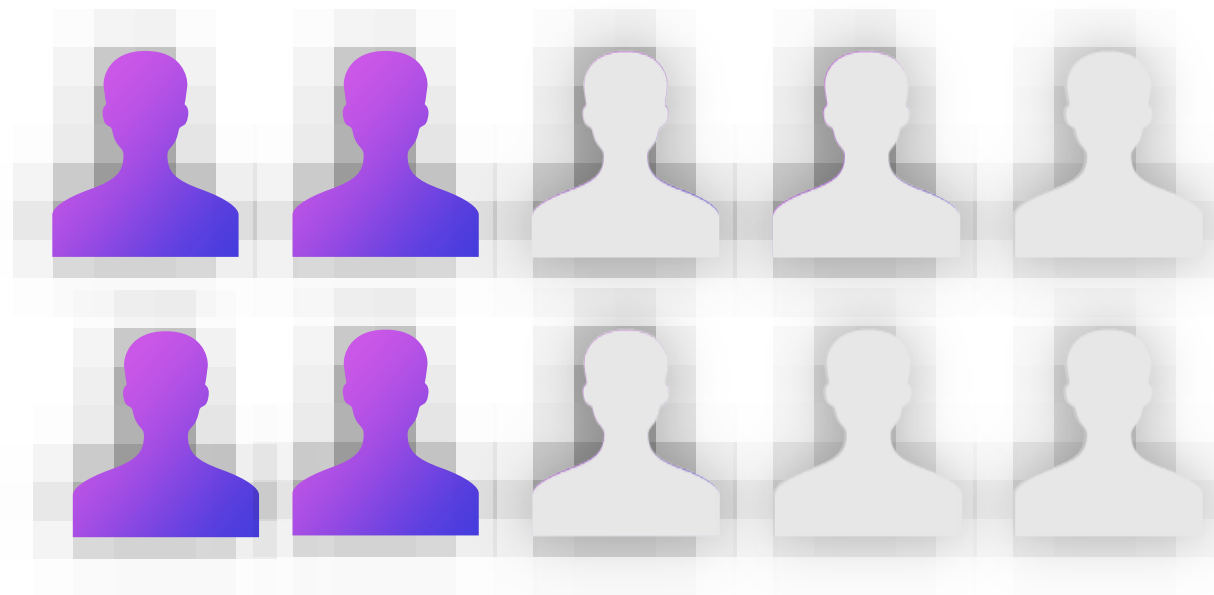
