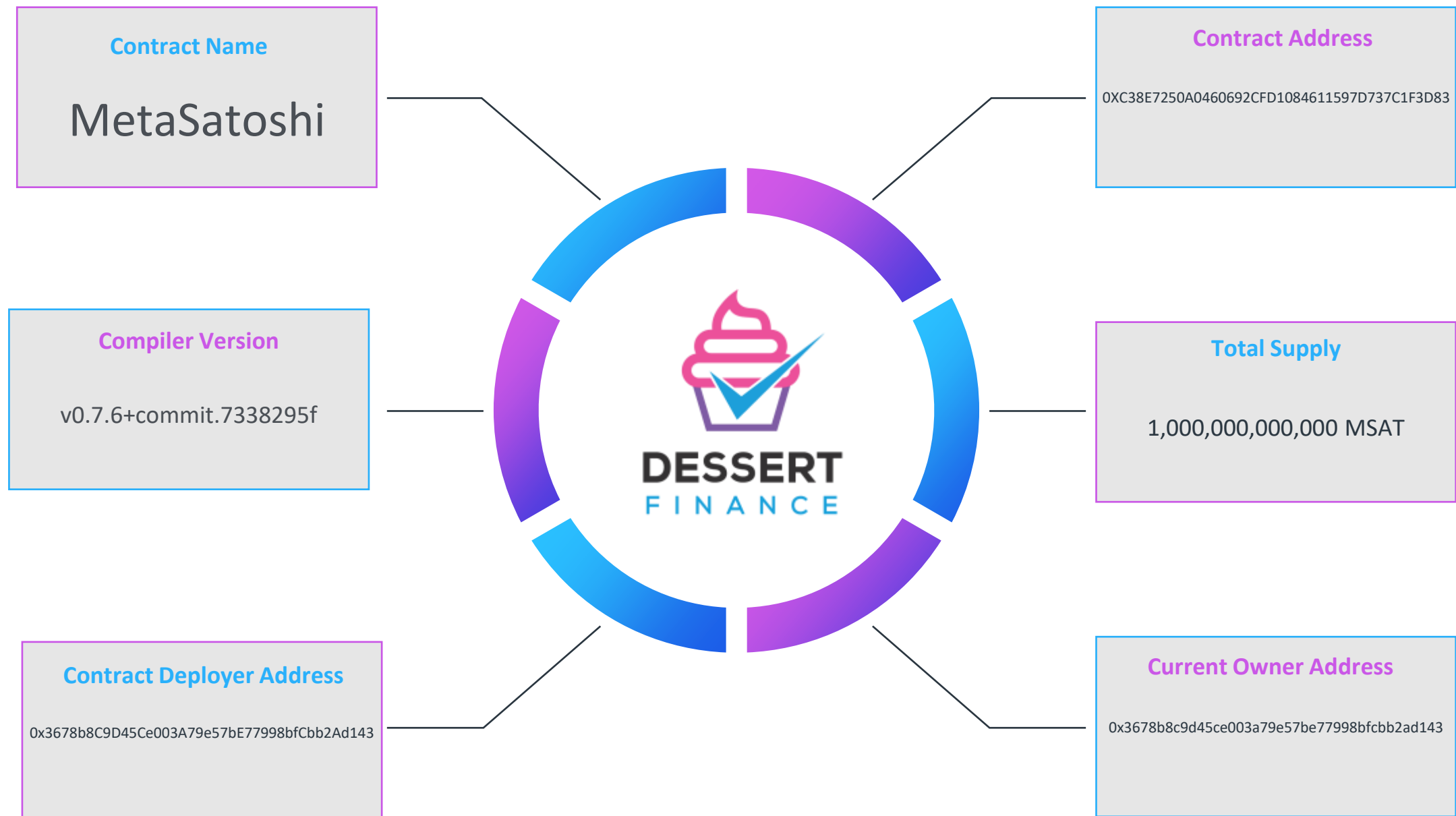

5% of every transaction will go to marketing and will be used as necessary to take MetaSatoshi to the moon!

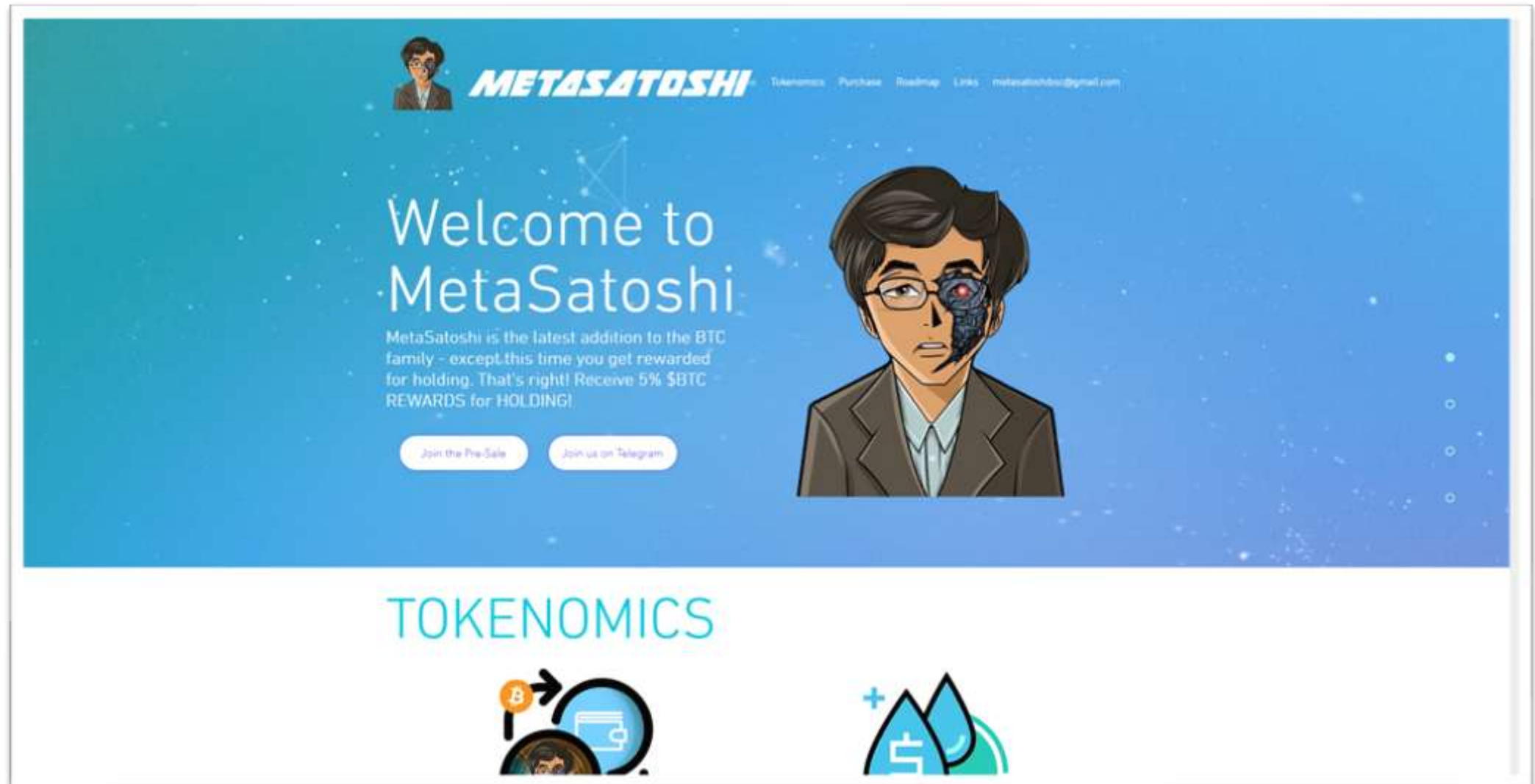


Anti-Bot

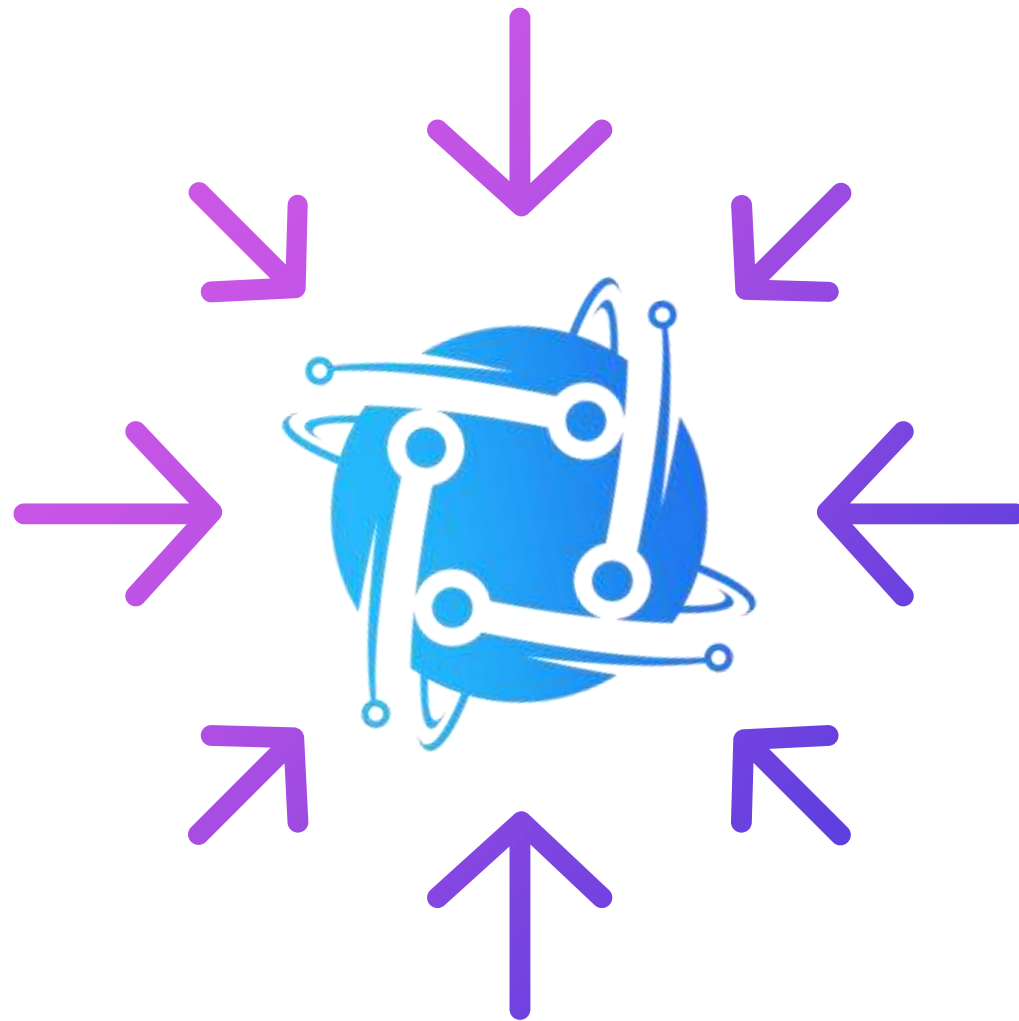
