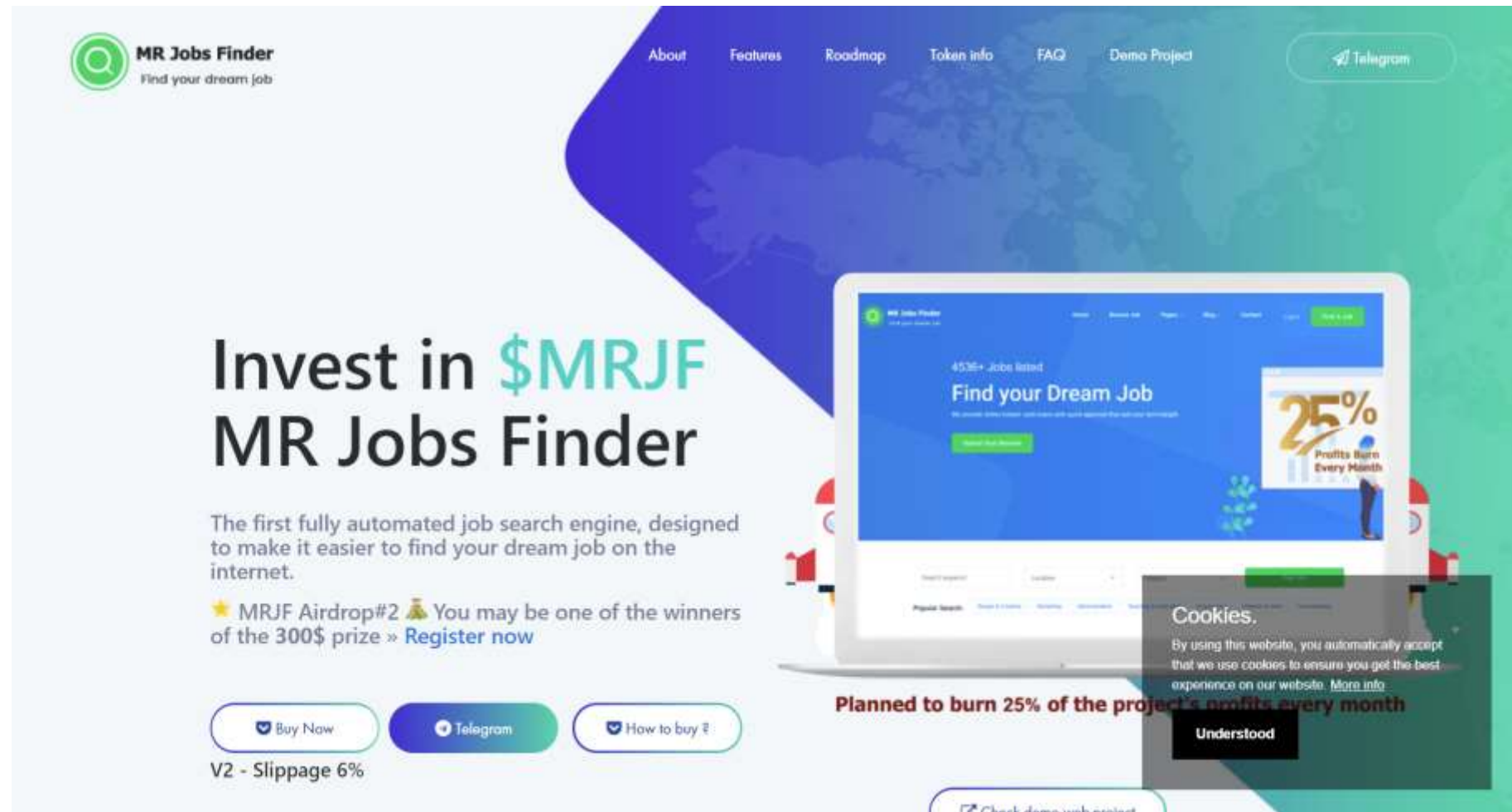

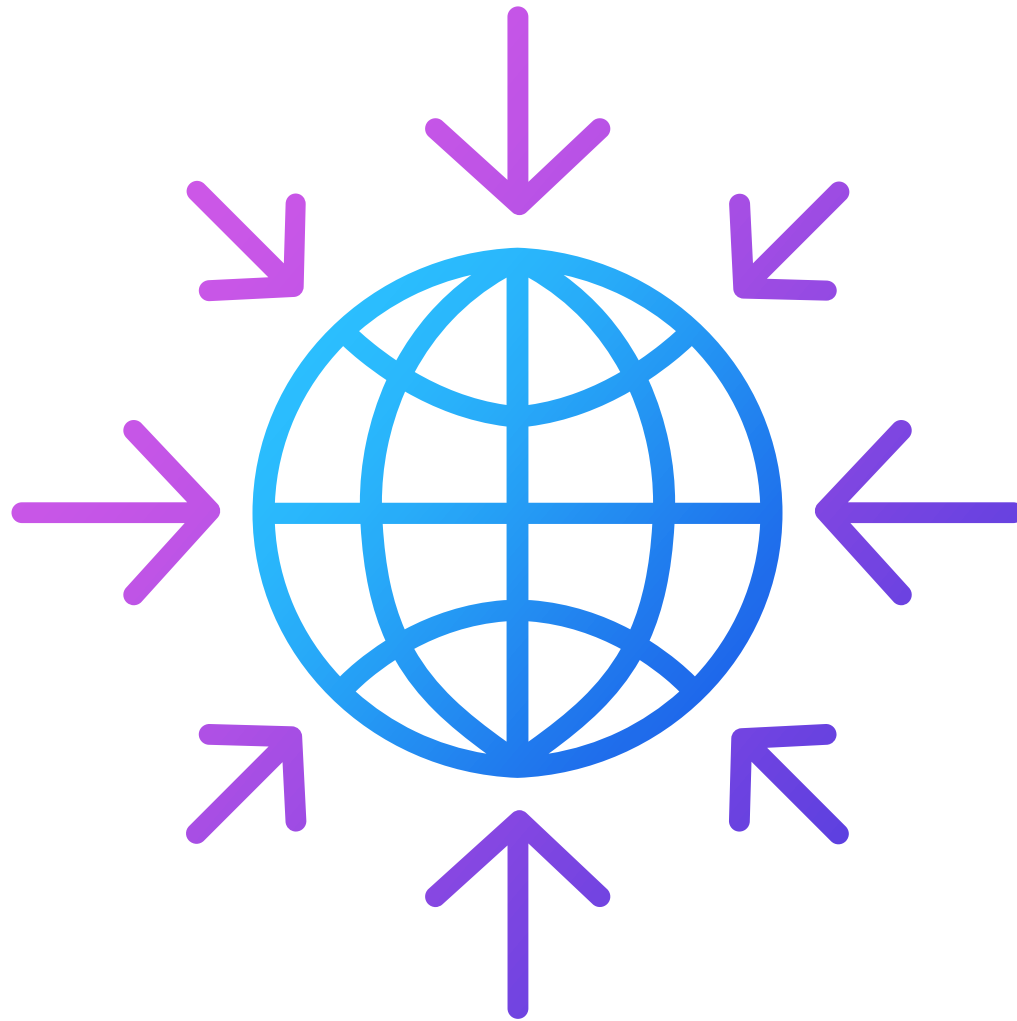
Above images are actual snapshots of the current live website of the project.

No additional issues were found on the website.

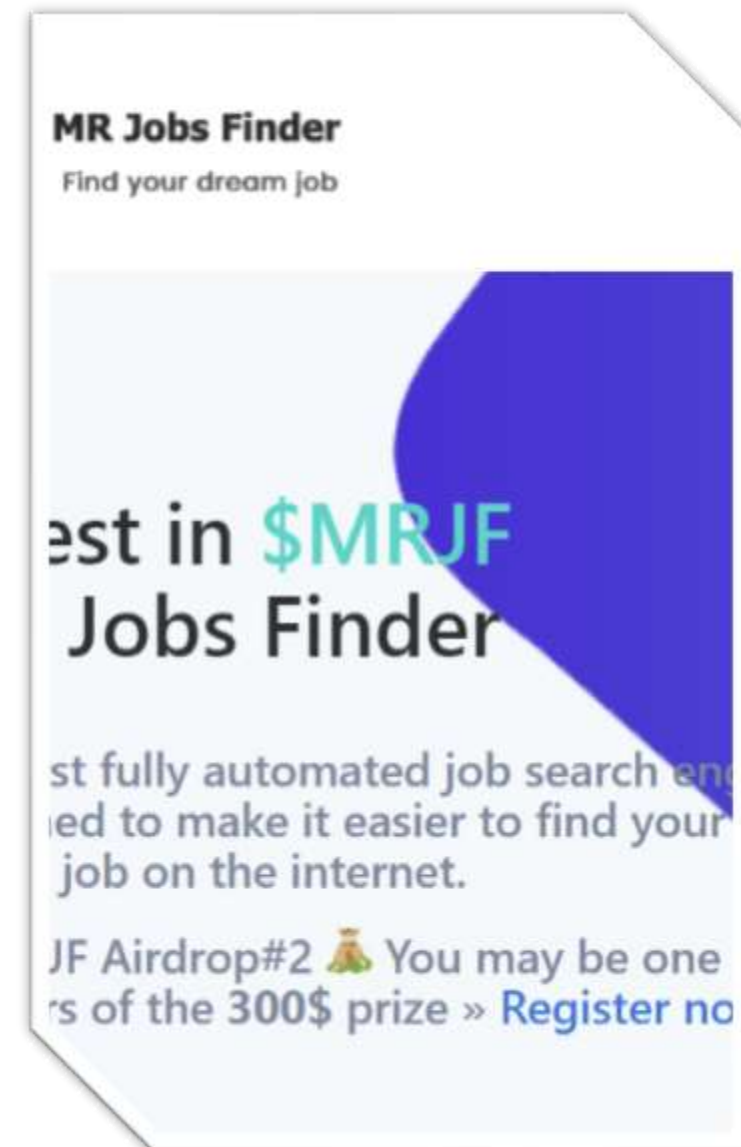
Website Part 3 – Responsive HTML5 & CSS3

Social and Web – Final Thoughts & Suggestions for Improvement

We were able to track down multiple social media channels for the project. Twitter, Telegram, Medium, Reddit, and YouTube were found.

All wallets for use by the team have been clearly outlined on the homepage. Mr Jobs Finder has put considerable effort to ensure the transparency of all their wallets and transactions.

It is important to note that there is a 5% tax on all transactions. There is a 4% transaction fee that is going to be used in a future rewards program and for the purpose of marketing and any project expenses that may need funding. An additional 1% transaction fee is added for token burns. 1% of every transaction is permanently removed from the supply.

Suggestions for Improvement

1. Get contract code verified fully on BSCScan
2. Fix JavaScript errors on website.

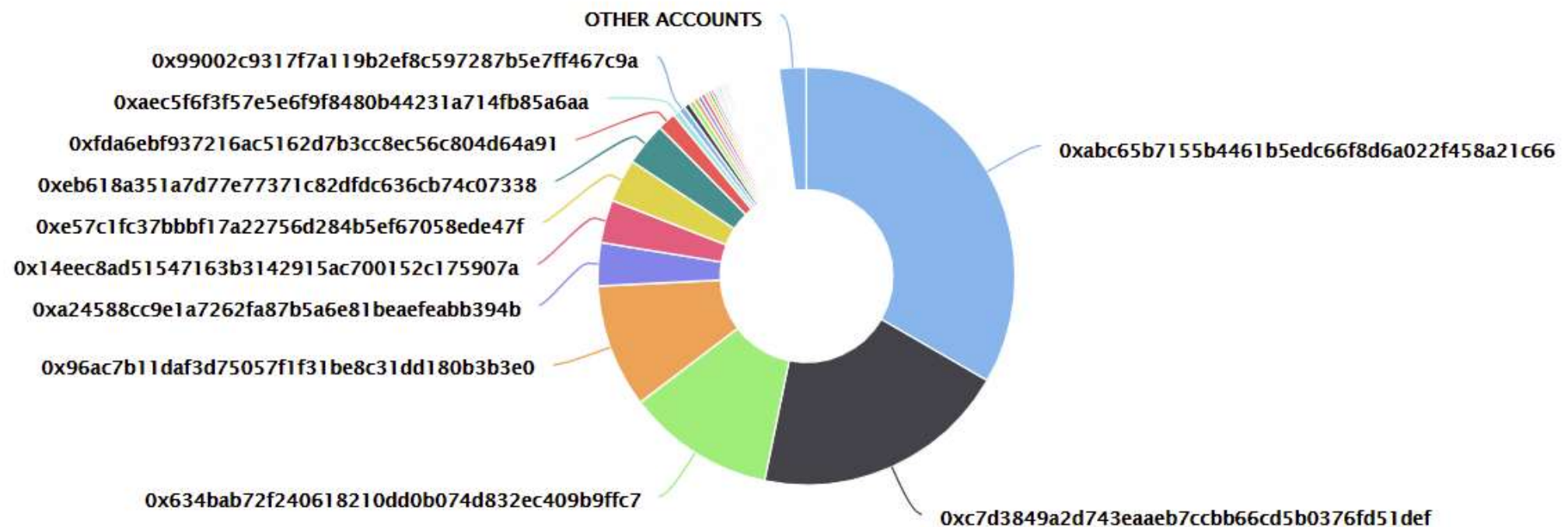


Top Token Holders

The 2nd largest holder is the marketing [wallet](#) holding 19.8% of the supply.

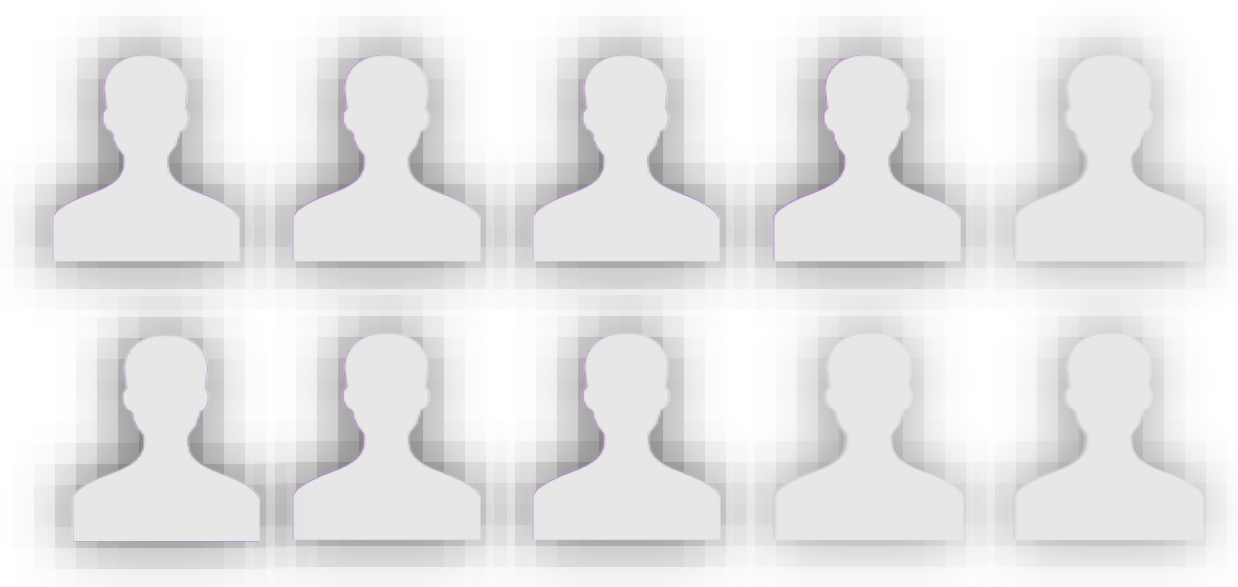
The 3rd largest holder was a [contract](#) holding 11.4% of the supply. This is the PancakeSwap liquidity pool.
