



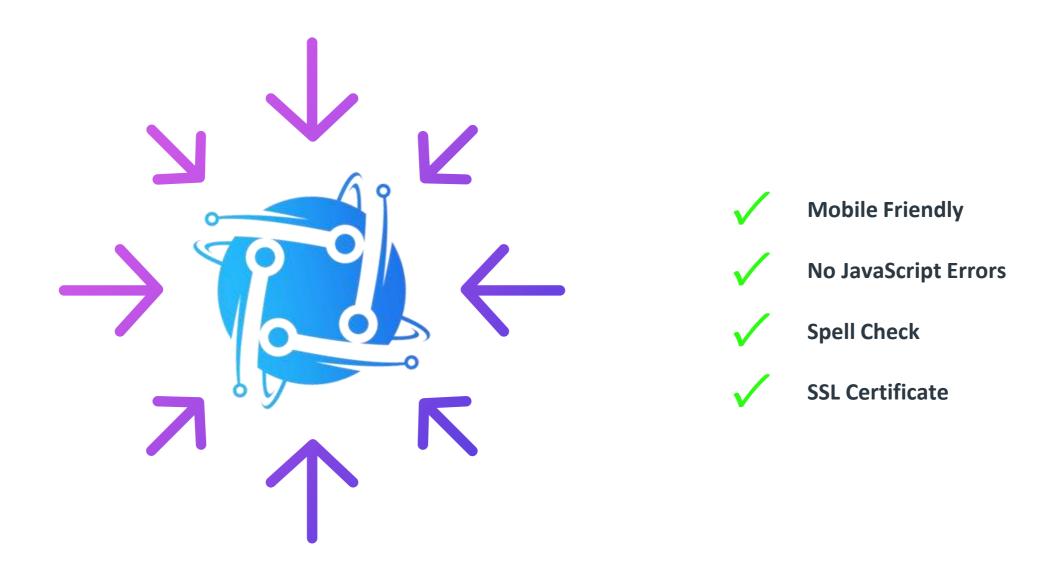


The website contained no severe JavaScript errors. No typos, or grammatical errors were present, and we found a valid SSL certificate allowing for access via https.




