


Above images are actual snapshots of the current live website of the project.

Website Part 2 – Checklist




The website contained a minor JavaScript error. No typos, or grammatical errors were present, and we found a valid SSL certificate allowing for access via https.

We were able to track down multiple social media channels for the project. Social Media channels included Twitter, Telegram, Reddit, Discord, Instagram, and Facebook. All social media channels had a healthy amount of activity.

It is important to note that there is an 6% tax on EVERY transaction including buys and sells. 1% is burned, 2% is provided to the liquidity pool, 2% goes to the marketing wallet, and 1% is distributed among the holders.

The Powercoin team reached out to Dessert Finance prior to launch to ensure maximum transparency. Dessert Finance has government issues IDs on file for 4 core team members. The team has been responsive and professional in answering questions in a timely manner and ensuring they can do everything possible to be transparent before, during, and after launch.

Suggestions for improvement:


- 1. Make links to external pages open in new tabs

PowerCoin Top 100 Token Holders



Location Audit


We were able to identify the primary location for the project as Cyprus.
